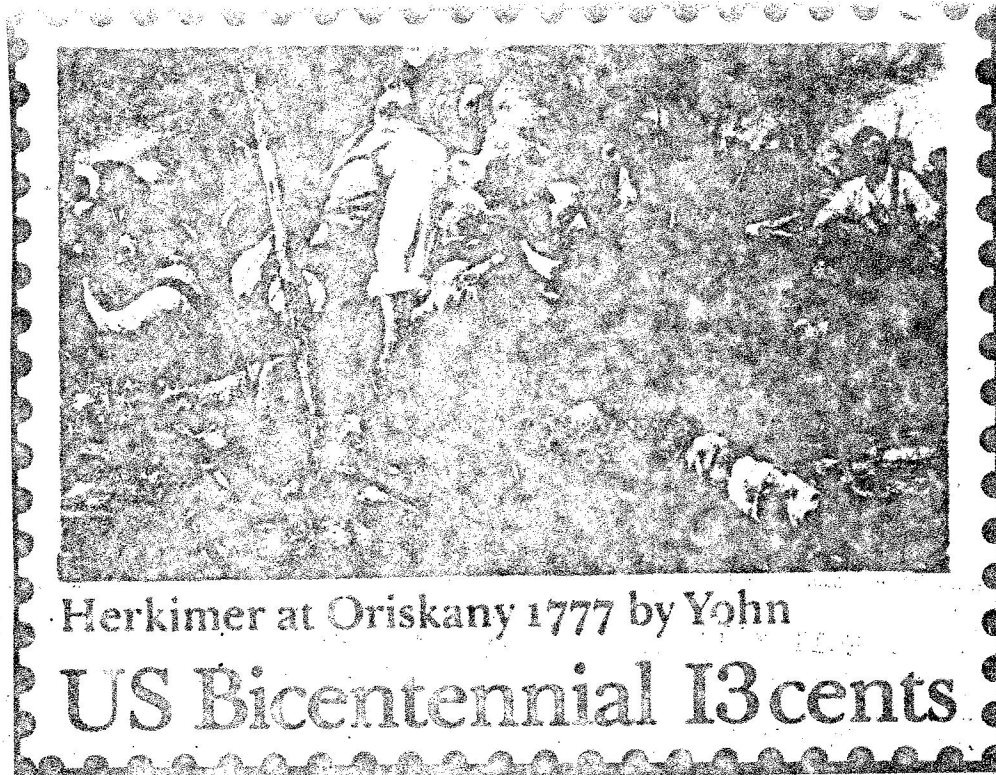

Herkimer at Oriskany

Historians cite the Battle of Oriskany as a significant contribution to the failure of the British northern campaign and one of the hardest fought hand-to-hand battles of the Revolutionary War. The U.S. Postal Service will issue this

13-cent semi-jumbo stamp Aug. 6 in Herkimer, N.Y., as the fourth Bicentennial Series issue of 1977. The design is based on a Frederick Yohn painting. Further details were given in Linn's June 27, page 1.



U.S. Peace Bridge design

Design of the U.S. Postal Service's commemorative stamp dedicated to the 50th anniversary of the completion of the Peace Bridge between the United States and Canada has been revealed (Linn's July 4, page 1). The blue stamp will be issued Aug. 4 in a joint ceremony at Kleinhans

Music Hall on Symphony Circle in Buffalo, N.Y., with officials of both the U.S. and Canada participating. Canada's commemoration was illustrated in Linn's June 27 issue on page 1. The Peace Bridge spans the Niagara River between Buffalo and Fort Erie, Ont.
