***** "EDITORIAL" ***** by John Kellas

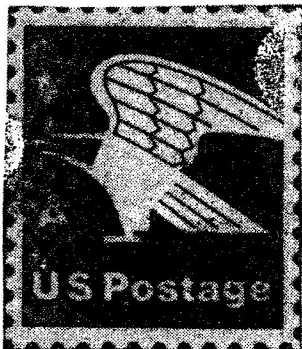

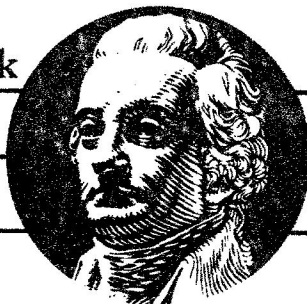
June 22nd - NO MEETING ++++++
