stamp was released Oct. 3, 1928
honoring Maj. Gen. William Crawford
Gorgas and is still in use today
after being reprinted several times!

POSTAL NOTES

Effective Jan. 1st the official
two letter U.S.P.S. abbreviation
for the Mariana Islands became
" CM " (the Commonwealth of the
Northern Marianas) replacing the
previous "TT" (Trust Territory of
the Pacific Islands) designation.

ELMIRA STAMP CLUB SUPPORT

During the Oct '78 RPA meeting,
the RPA membership voted and
decided that it would help
support the Elmira Stamp Club's
campaign for a proposed U.S.
postage stamp depicting a
Glider. The stamp would help
celebrate the 50th anniversary
of the First National Soaring
Contest held at Elmira in 1930.
This stamp would fit into the
new Pioneer Aviation series
following the Lindbergh Spirit
of St. Louis issue and the
Wright Brothers issue. A letter
is being composed and will be
forward to the Citizen's Stamp Advisory Committee supporting the issuance
of this stamp during the 1980 stamp program in Elmira (FDI location).
