Wheel of Fortune **Steam Boat 1845-47**



Side Wheel steamer

Dated August 12, 1846

Newspaper ad Sept. 24, 1846

For Louisville, Evansville, Smithland, Paducah, Randolph, Memphis, Providence, bijecton, and all the Mississippi Bends,—
The superior light with steamer WHEEL OF FORTUNE, J. Murphy, the ter, will leave for the above and all intermediate landing, ou SATURDAY, 26th instant, at 5 o'clock, P. M. For height or passage, apply on board, foot of Lafayette street, or to \$24 T. B. SMITH, 14 Poydras st.

July 11, 1847 Burned on Ohio river LOUISVILLE, Ky. – NEW ORLEANS, La., 1846 SFL; STEAM / 10; Steamboat "WHEEL OF FORTUNE"

Stampless folded letter (SFL) from Louisville, 12/31 August 1846, w/ New Orleans S T E A M 10 and manuscript: "Wheel of Fortune." ... Addressed to: P.N. Wood Esq / Gas Office / New Orleans

Steamboat "WHEEL OF FORTUNE," built in 1844-45; side-wheel cargo/passenger steamer, 165 tons. She was rather small, fast running, wivery light draught.
...See scans of two of her advertisements, one of which, June 17, 1846 (Daily Picayune), reveals she also ventured coastwise along the Guif of Mexico. ...The other is dated Sept. 24, 1846 (Daily Picayune).

She plied the Mississippi — Red — Ohio Rivers ...and some waters in between. Her primary (usual) run was New Orleans — Louisville—round trip w/ many stops in between. On occasion, she would venture to Cincinnati...almost always returning to New Orleans. She was noted at St. Louis in 1845, ...and Louisville as early as January 15, 1845. Masters at the rhelm were usually Murphy, Read, and Bell.

P. C. Shannon, Commission Merchant Broker, and General Agent, 51 Tchoupitoulas Street, New Orleans, La.; or...M.F. Rainey, 25 New Levee, ...or T.B. Smith, 14 Poydras Street, ...or E.B. Dempsey & Co., 29 New Levee, were four of her several agents in New Orleans.

Concerning subject SFL (August 12) voyage from Louisville to New Orleans:

The Louisville Daily Courier of August 13, 1846, states: DEPARTURES. AUGUST 12, 1846. "WHEEL OF FORTUNE," for N.O.

The Louisville Daily Courier of August 15, 1846, states: "...The steamer P and Owensboro, Ky.), and the WHEEL OF FORTUNE aground at that place. tes: "...The steamer PALESTINE reports only 4 feet and 5 inches water on Flint Island Bar (between Louisville

The Daily Picayune of August 30, 1846, states: SHIPPING INTELLIGENCE. SUNDAY MORNING, AUGUST 30, 1846; ...Cleared Yesterday (29th). ...Arrived ... STEAMBOATS. WHEEL OF FORTUNE, Read, fm Louisville. (18 days to N.O. ...after being stuck.)

—Then... at 3:00a.m. on July 11, 1847, the steamer "WHEEL OF FORTUNE," caught fire and burned near Little Hurricane Island (Daviess County, Ky.) on the Ohio River. ... She was in service less than 3 years.

...Scarce domestic waterways manuscript name-of-boat marking.


