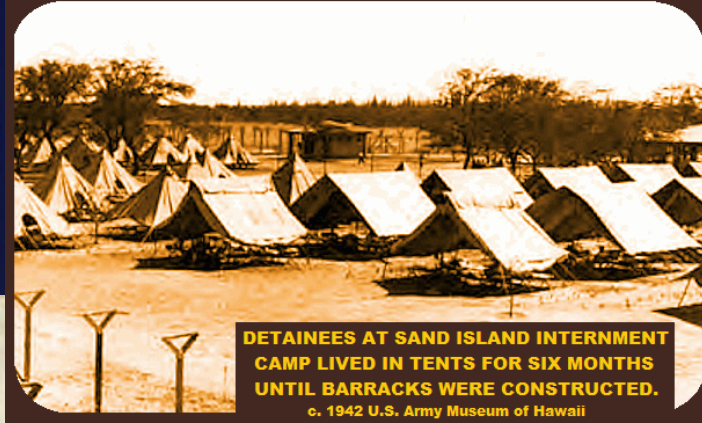
Censored "Win the War" first day cover mailed to Greenland.



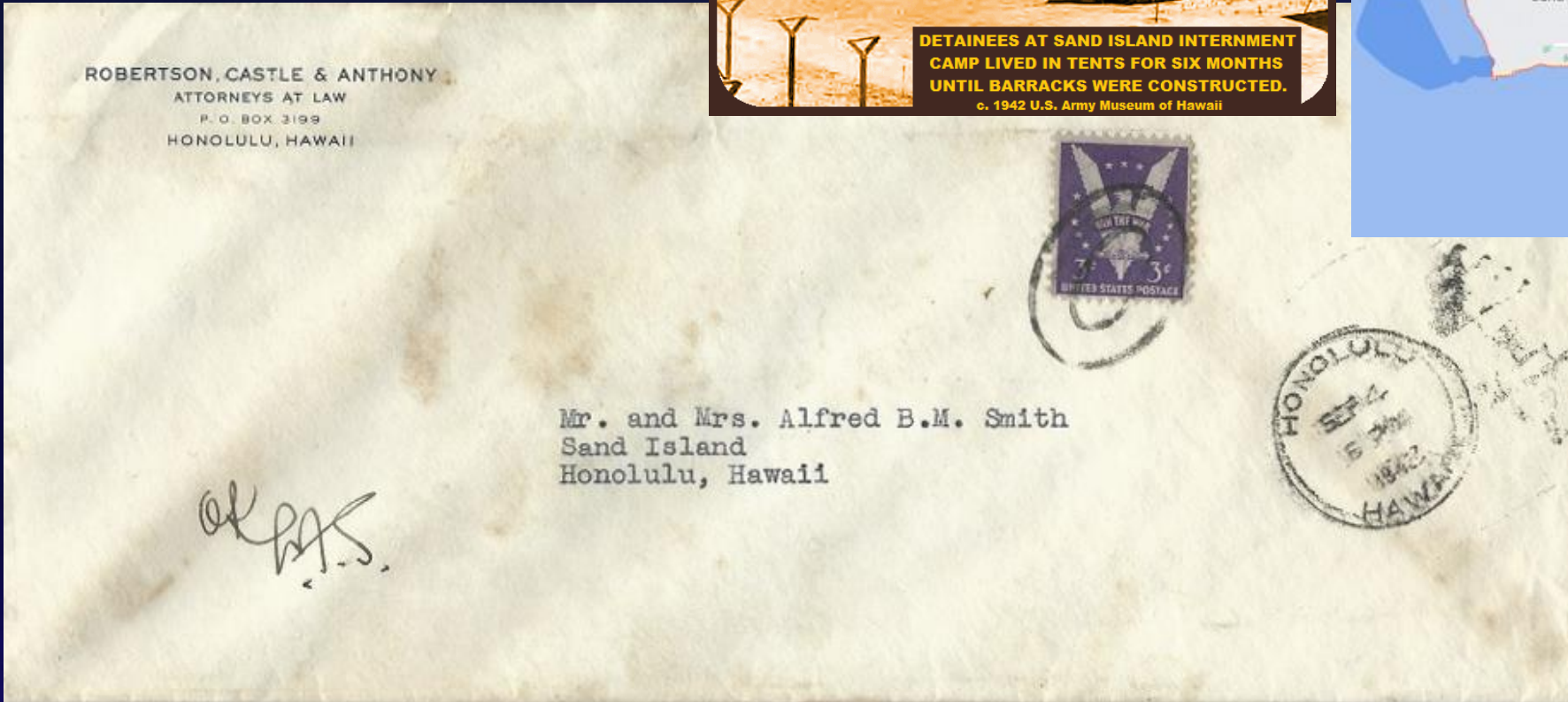
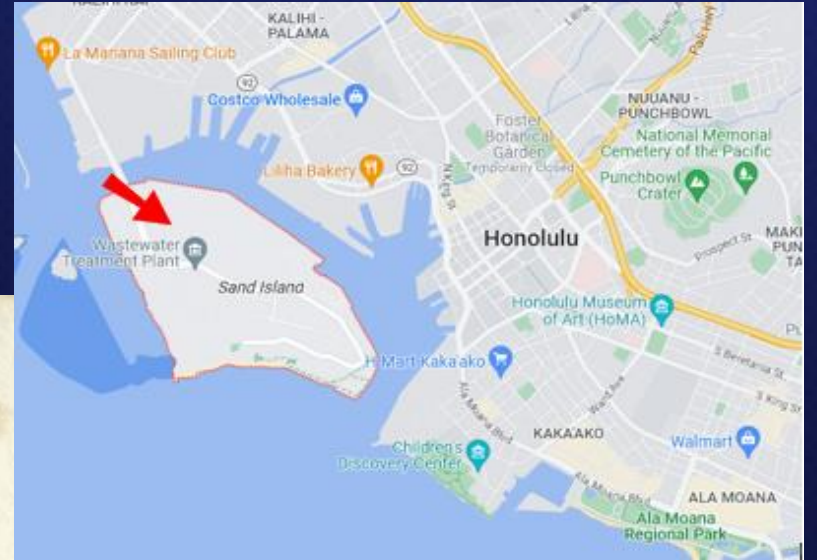
Mail from one Japanese Internment camp to another.

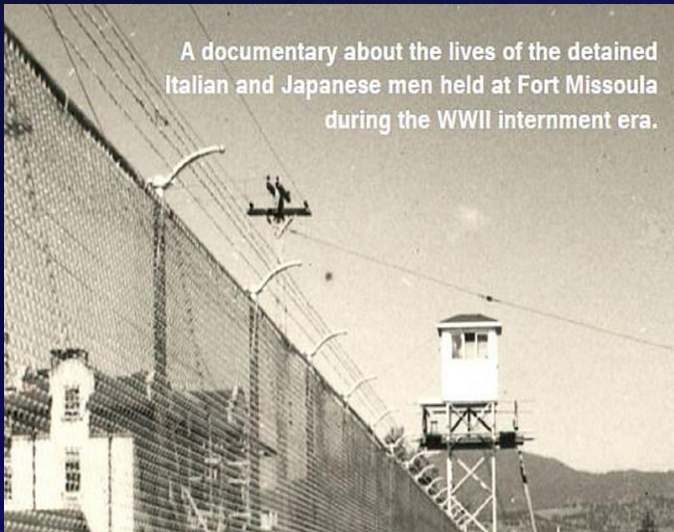

A documentary about the lives of the detained Italian and Japanese men held at Fort Missoula during the WWII internment era.

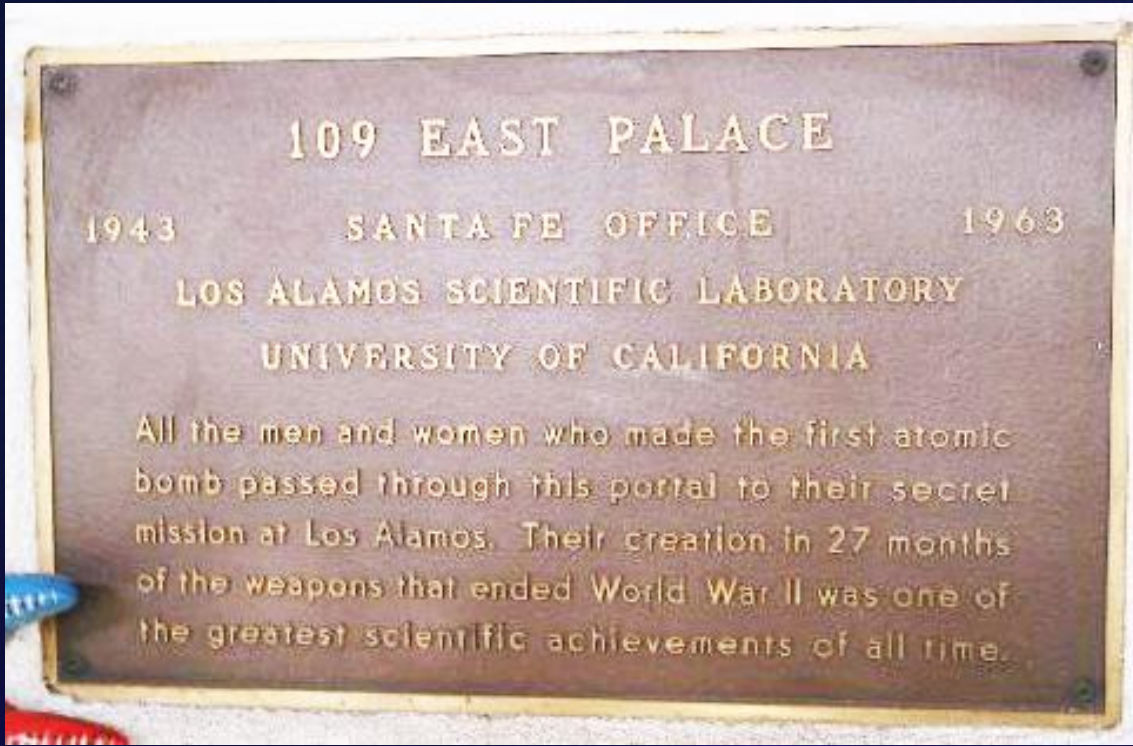

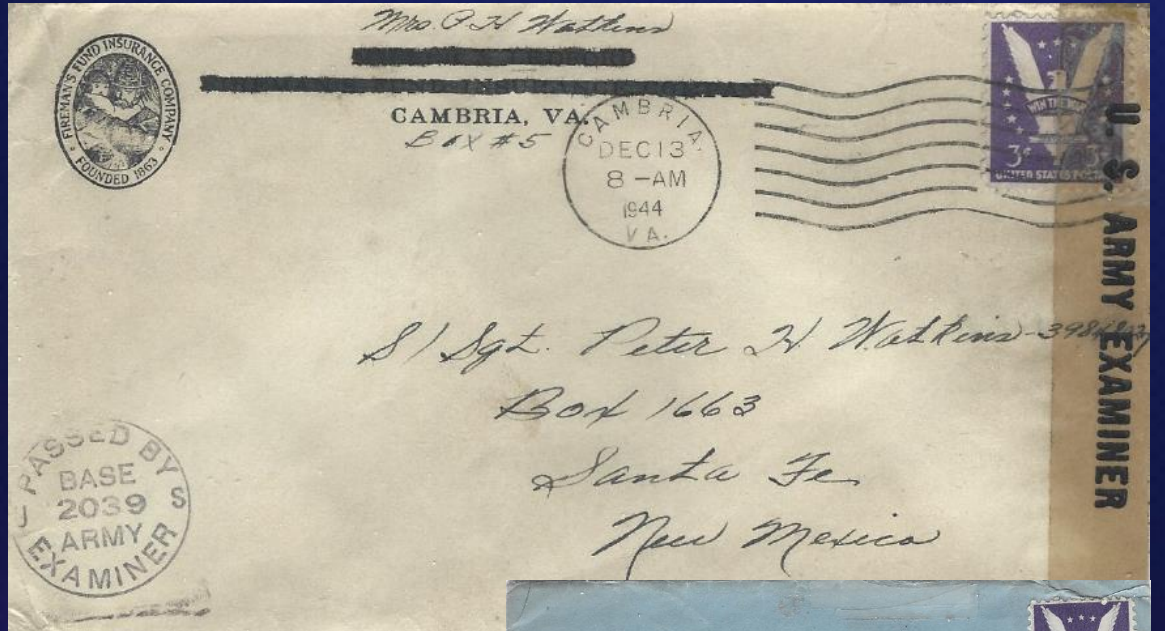

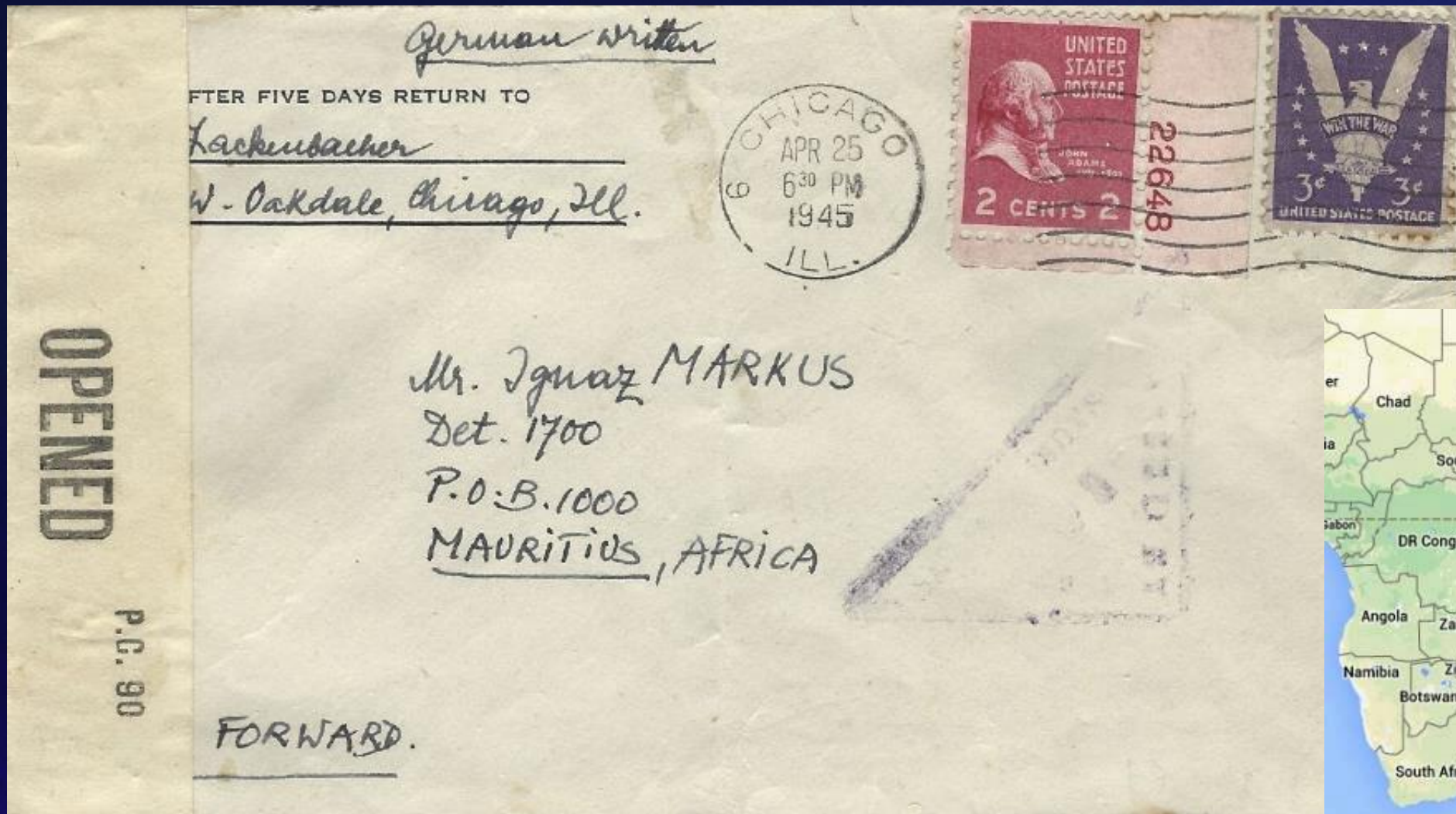
Censored cover sent to Alien Enemy Internment camp.

(until the end of 1944, P.O. Box 1663 was used for both types of technical personnel)

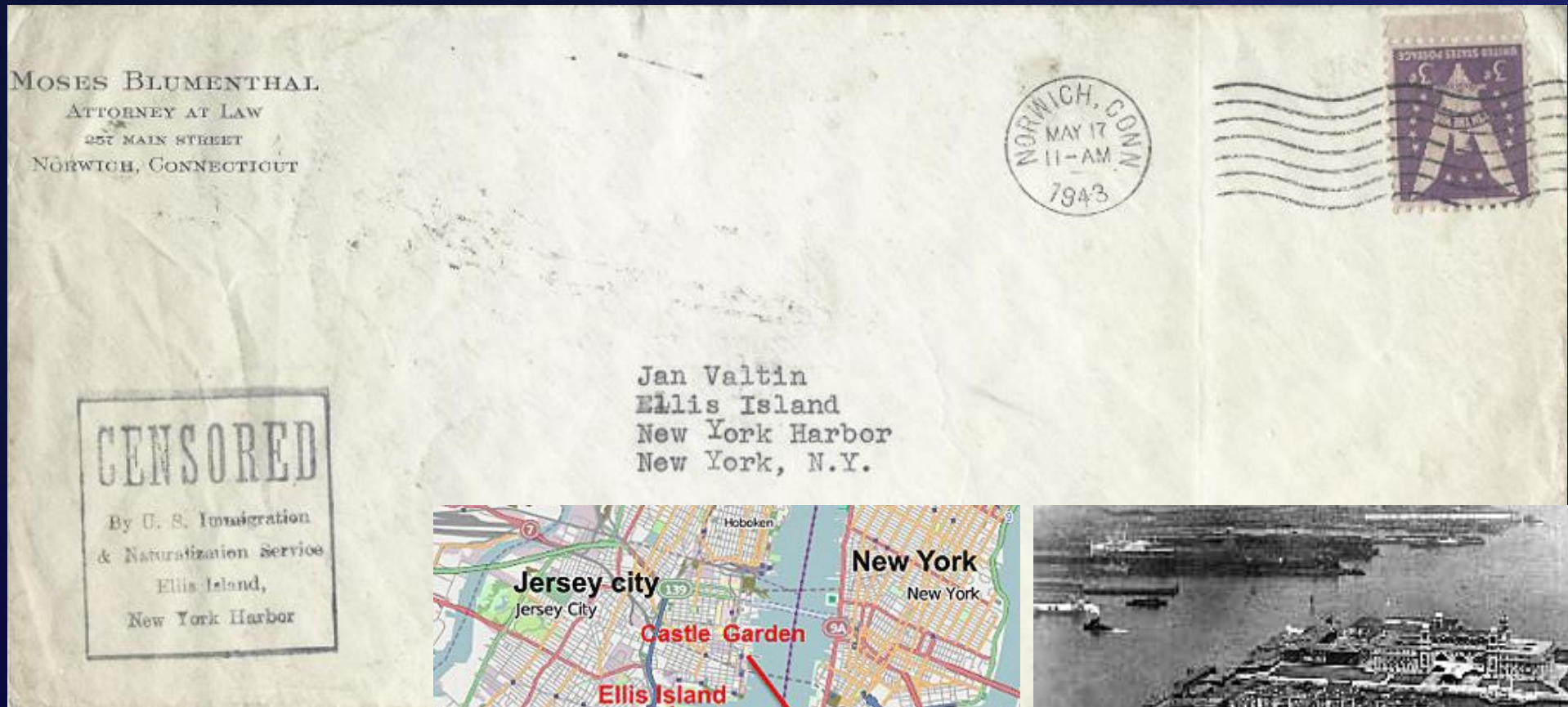


Two covers mailed to secret “atomic” PO box addresses.



Sent to Jewish Internment Camp. Note “German Written.”

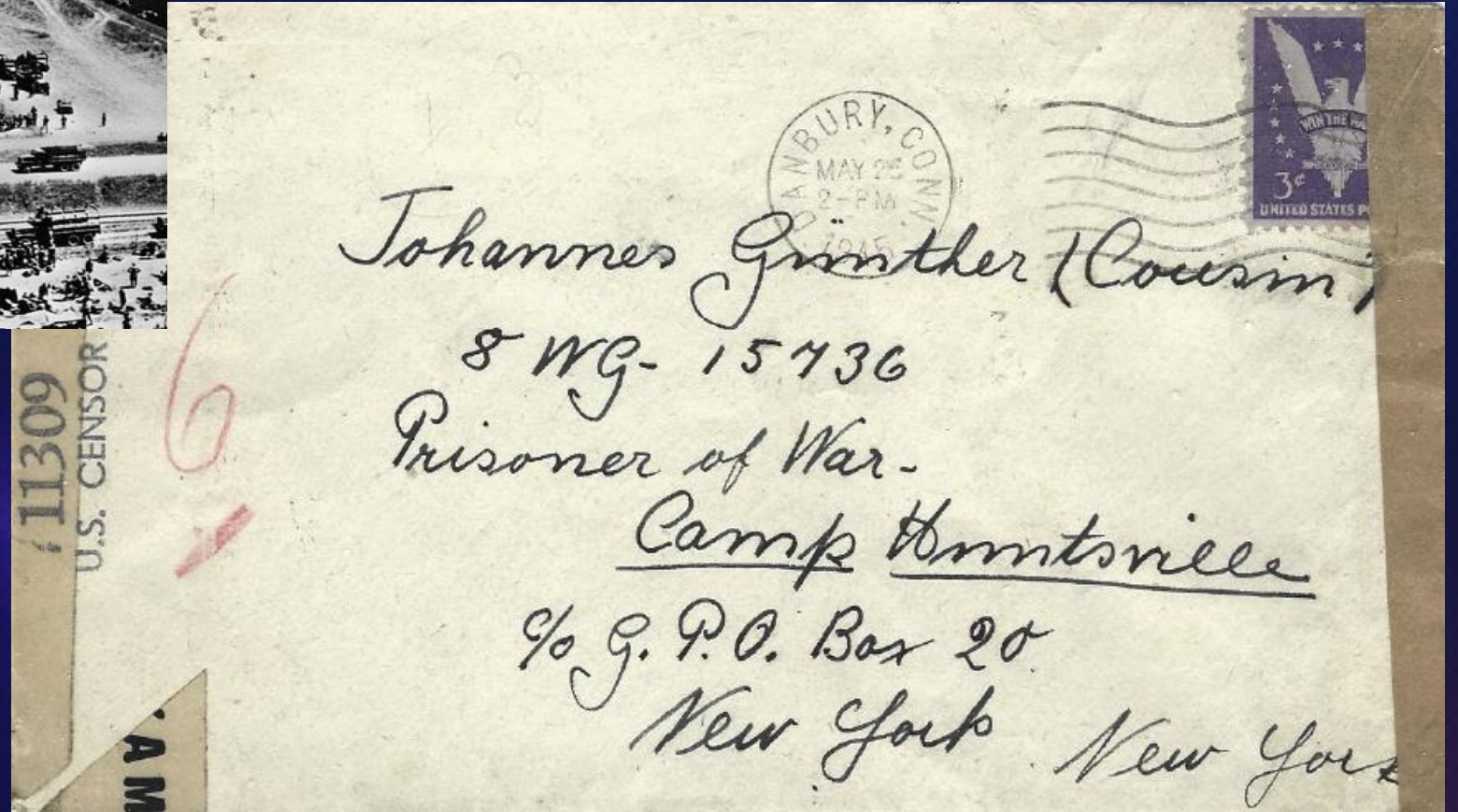




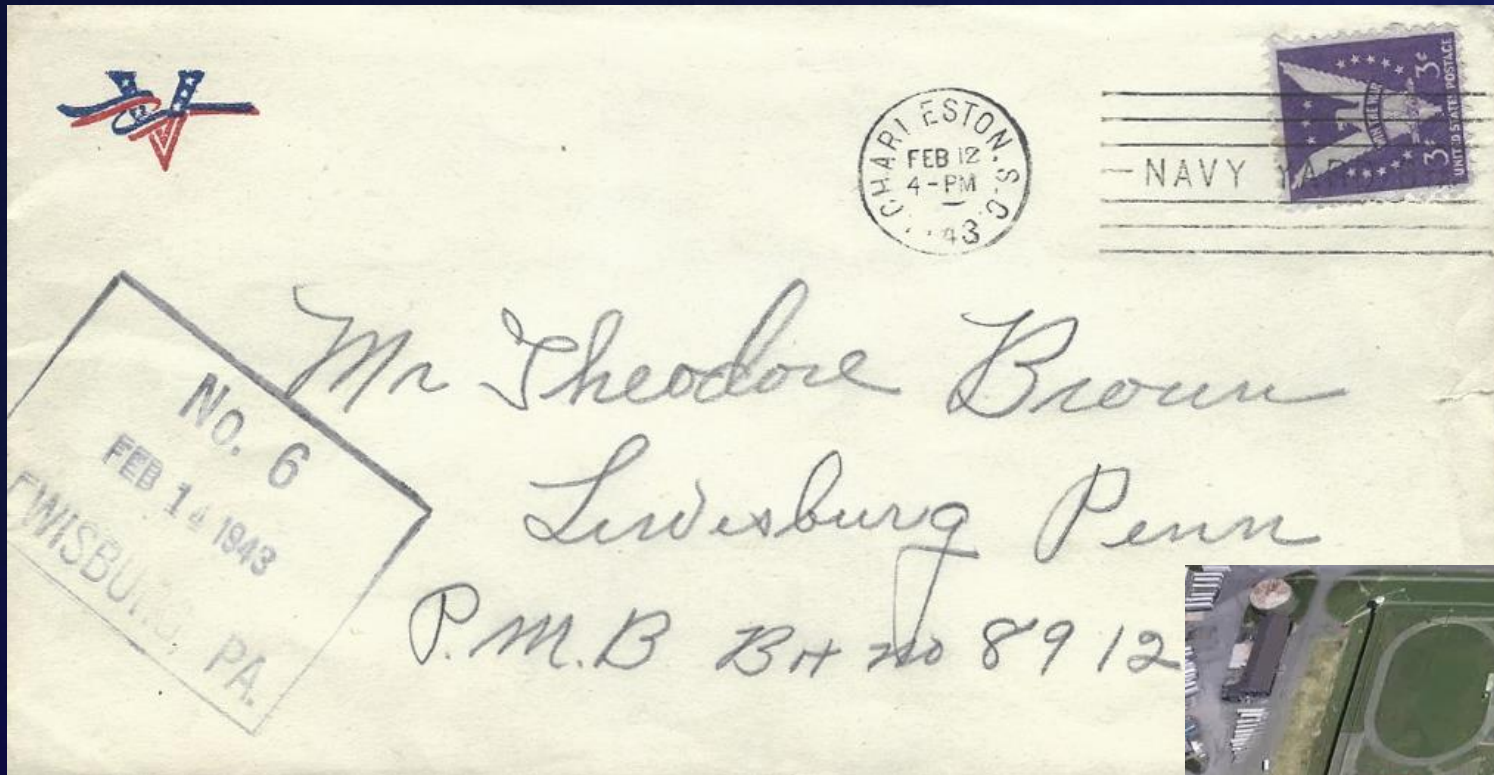
One of several temporary detention camps run by the Department of Justice for mostly German and Italian national POWs and enemies of the state.



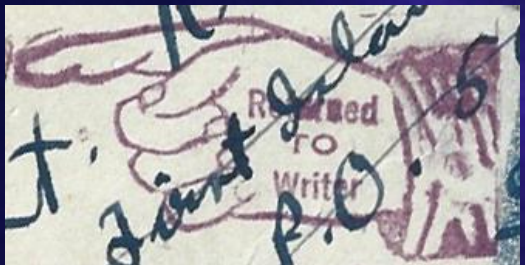
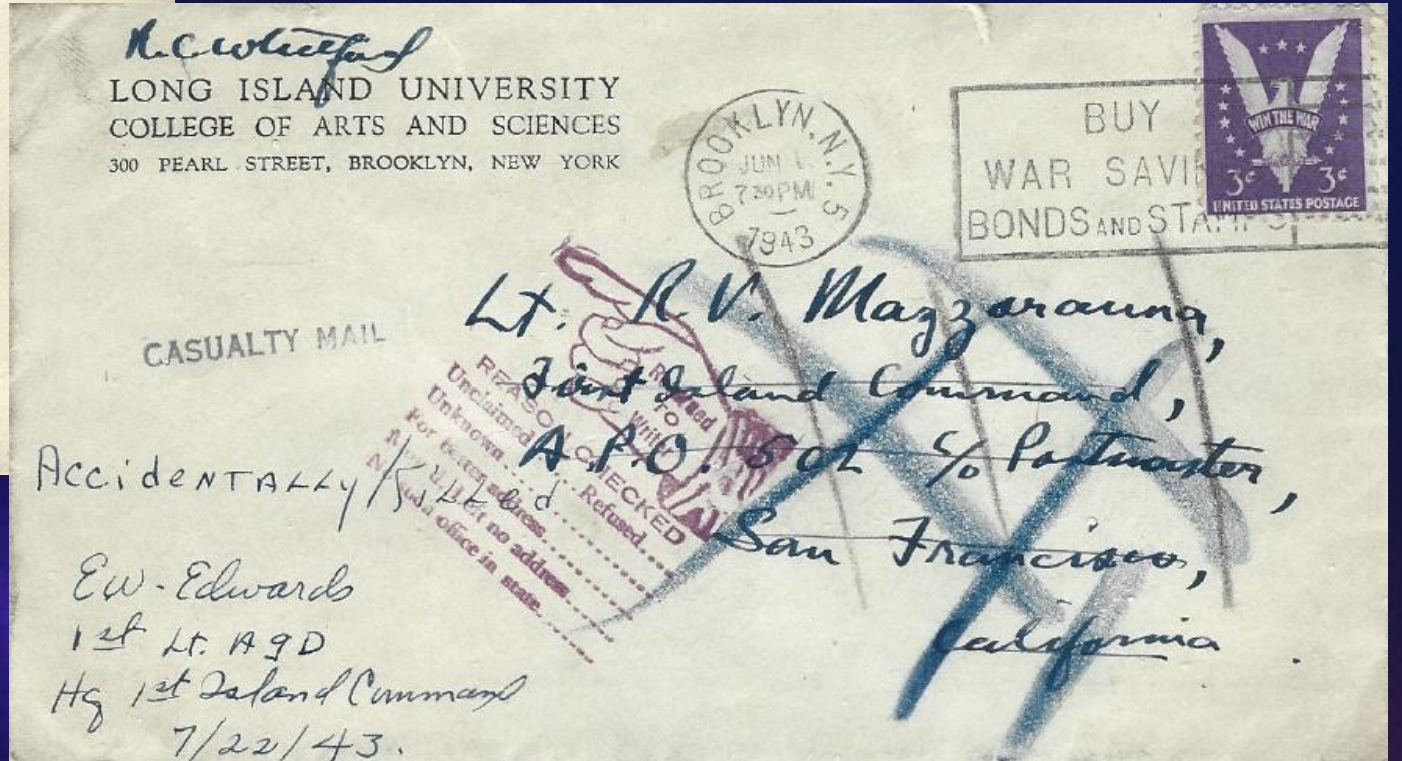
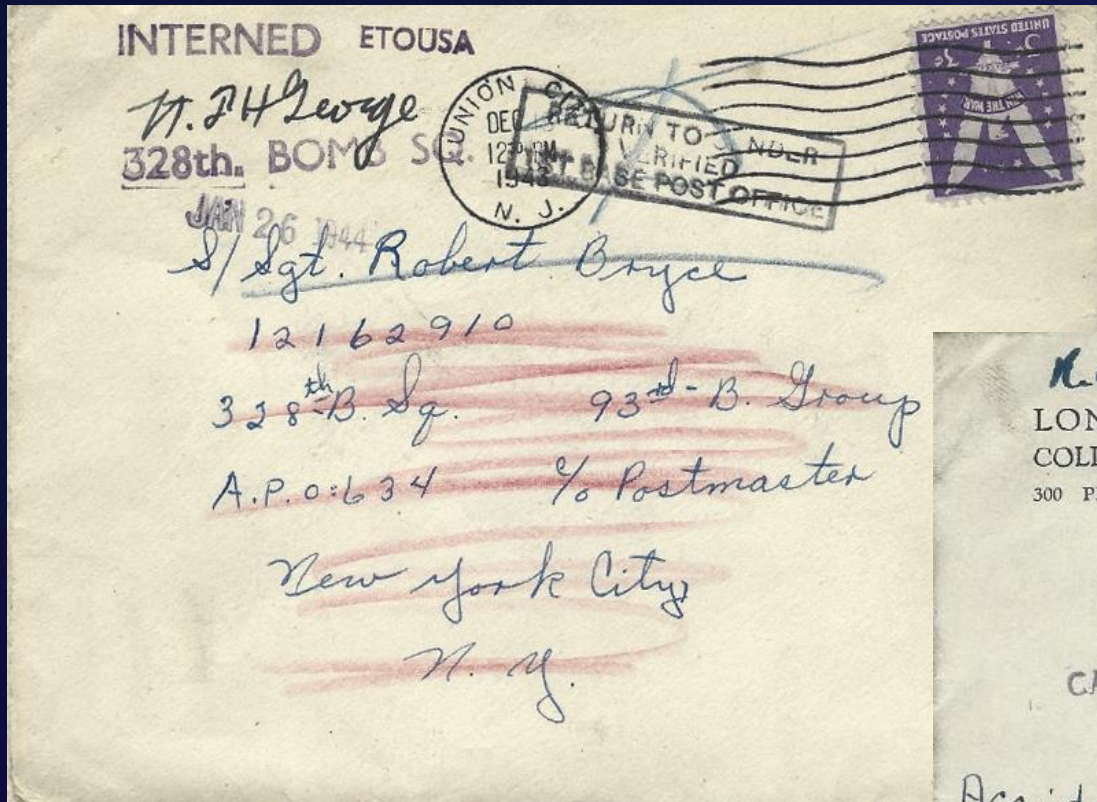
Ellis Island cover - lawyer to a detained immigrant.



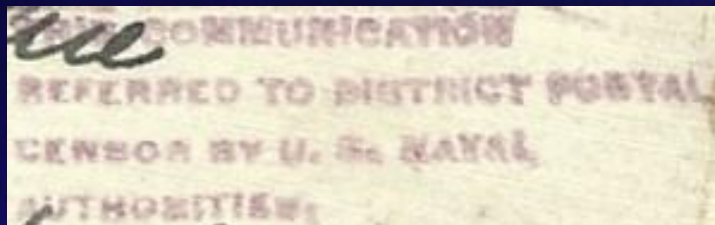
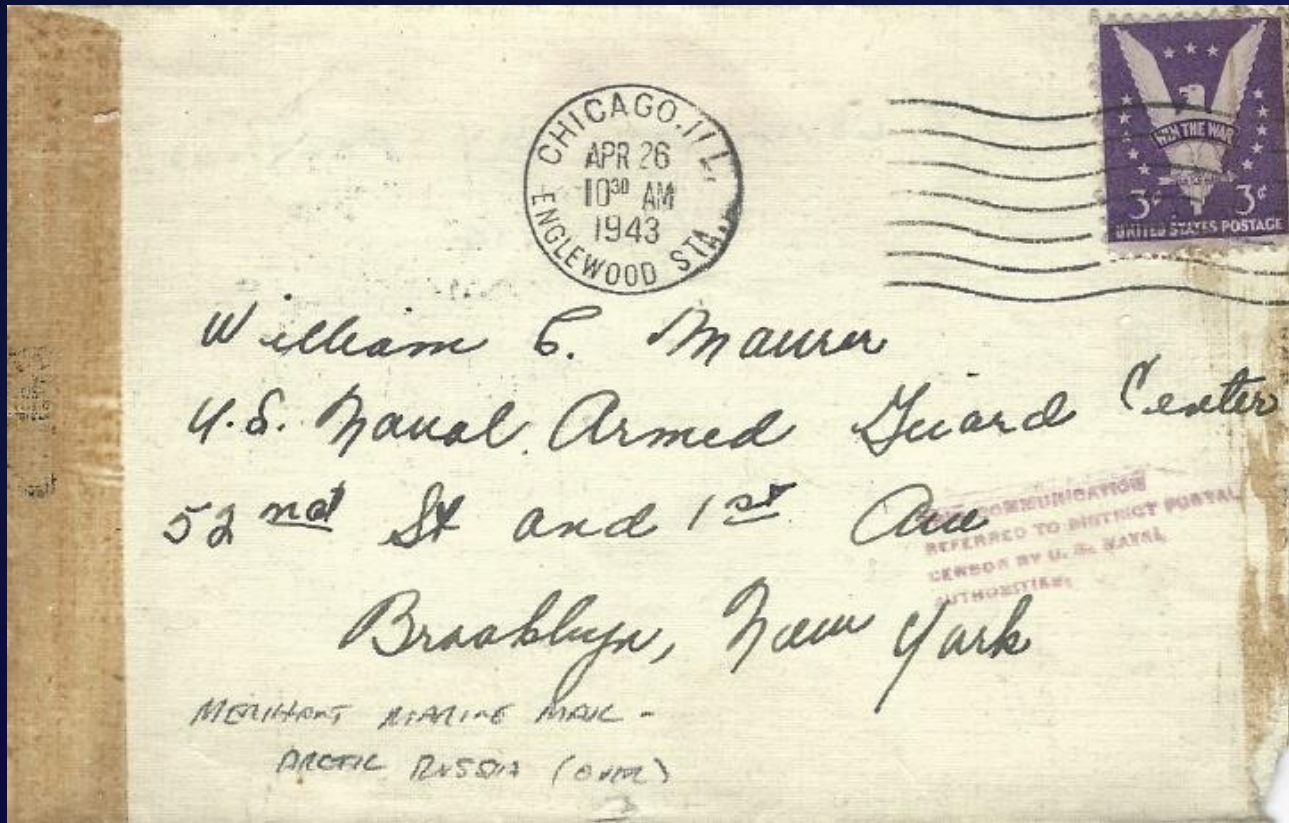
Mailed to a German POW housed at the Huntsville, TX camp.



To a prisoner at the Federal Penitentiary in Lewisburg, PA.



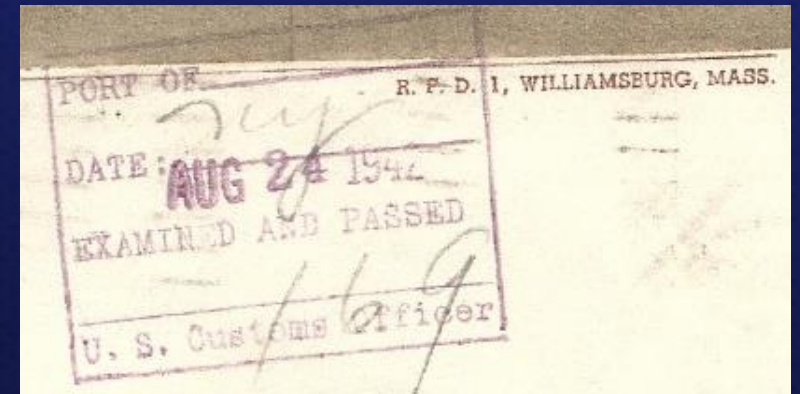
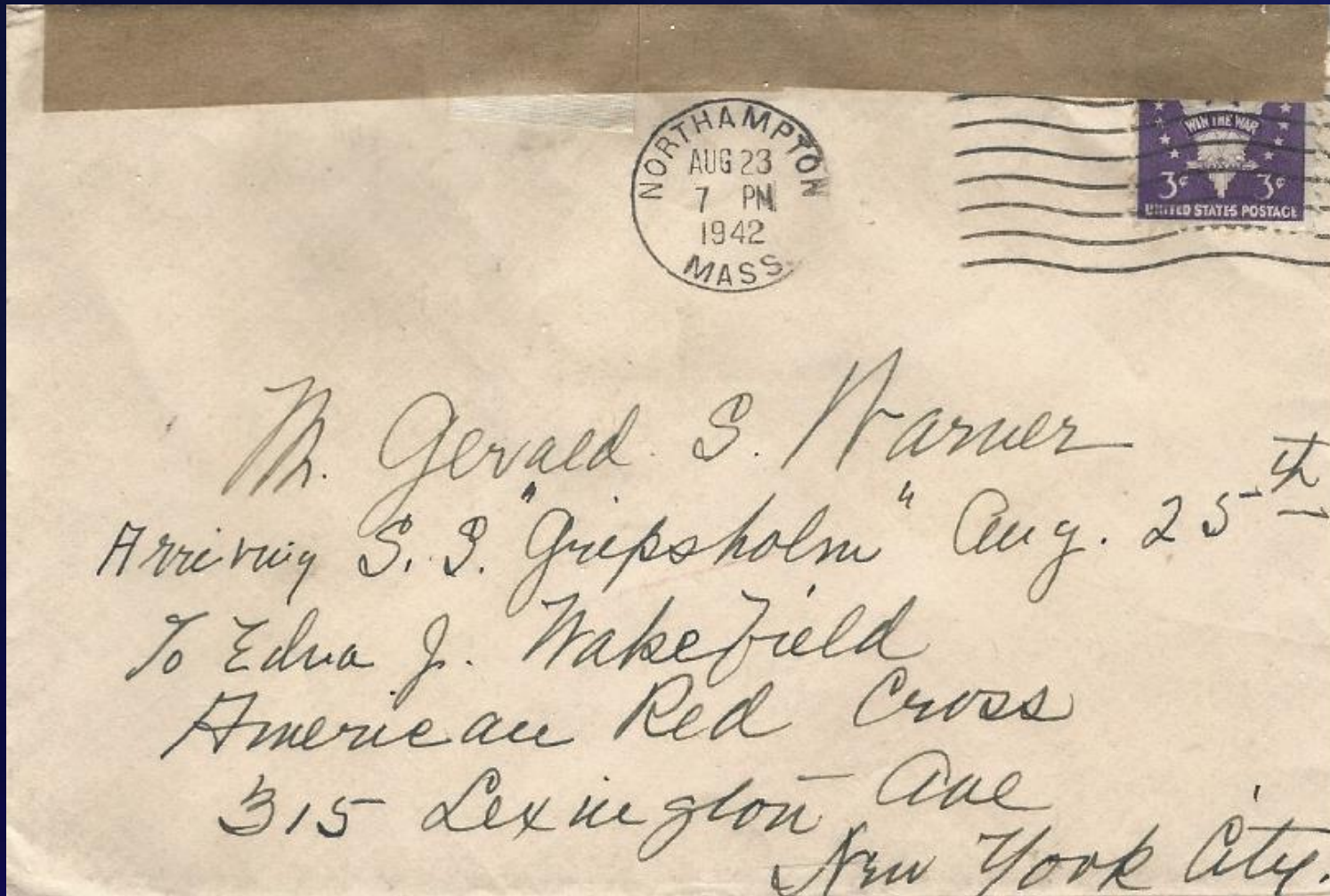
