THE SPACE RACE FROM INTERNATIONAL GEOPHYSICAL YEAR (IGY) TO GEMINI 12



Information on the early US flights of Explorer 1, a piece of "Mylar" from the gantry, ECHO 1, RANGER 1&2, TELSTAR 1, MARINER 4, RELAY, SYNCOM, EARLY BIRD (COMSAT) along with the first Mailgram from the United States Postal Service.

Covers for the first Chimpanzees ENOS, Little Joe, and Bonnie. Photographs of "hand prints" of Alan Shepard and John Glenn from Memorial statue in Titusville, Florida. launch and recovery covers from the Atlantic & Pacific oceans. Finally a dedication cover for the Challenger STS-51 flight.
