- 7) Double weight third class printed matter rate paid with a 2 cent horizontal coil.
- 8) A 2 cent horizontal coil paying the first class treaty rate to England on a mourning cover.
- Wrapper with a 1 cent horizontal coil to Sweden paying the third class printed matter rate to a foreign destination.
- 10) Postcard with a 1 cent horizontal coil to England, short paid, assessed a penalty of 10 centimes, with a first issue English postage due affixed.
- 11) Letter short paid with a 2 cent vertical coil and assessed a 30 centimes penalty on the maiden voyage of the SS Stockholm to Goteburg, Sweden.
- 12) A Territorial usage of a 2 cent horizontal pair to Guam that was forwarded.
- 13) A 2 cent vertical coil paying the first class letter rate from the Postal Agency in Shanghi, China.
- 14) A 1 cent line pair paying the first class domestic letter rate on a government penalty envelope.
- 15) Two 1 cent pre-canceled vertical coil singles paying the second class rate for periodicals.

New Additions & Changes: Since the last national APS show in Lincoln I have made some changes and additions to the exhibit to make it stronger. I rewrote and organized the production page so it makes more sense and is easier to understand. I have also added a few covers to the exhibit. The most significant items are a double weight usage from a United States Territory, 413 pair from Guam, and a second class wrapper with two 1 cent vertical pre-canceled singles. A few other covers include a two cent vertical and horizontal coil paying the treaty rates to Canada and England. A double weight third class usage paid with a 2 cent horizontal coil on a clasp envelope. A single and double rate usage of the 1 cent horizontal coil sent from the United States Postal Agency in Vera Cruz, Mexico. And a 2 cent vertical coil mailed from the postal agency in Shanghi, China.
