This is a study of the United States Scenic American Landscapes series of airmail stamps and stationery that were issued starting in 1999 and continue to present. This exhibit starts with the first stamp in the series, the 48¢ Niagara Falls stamp, issued May 1999 and continues through the 90¢ Hagatna Bay Guam stamp issued in June 2007.

Modern airmail items are often issued in the United States but finding actual uses or just seeing how this series of stamps work is important for future postal historians.

The exhibit is divided into 14 different sections according to the 14 items in this series. Each section features the stamps and/or stationery, first-day covers and related material, domestic/international uses if available, and additional items when appropriate.

A separate title page picturing the appropriate stamp/stationery will guide one through the entire exhibit. This page will indicate a guide to what type of items are in each section.
