

The synopsis:

‘Celebrating Our Hobby’ as an exhibit is meant to be a light-hearted look at how our hobby of stamp collecting celebrates its events. These are primarily stamp exhibitions. Included in the exhibit are cinderella (or label) issues, souvenir covers, post cards, souvenir sheets and special issue stamps all relating to or promoting a stamp exhibition of some sort somewhere.
