Disputing the conclusion of Captain Boteler who considered it a fact that there is no communication whatsoever between the Rivers, navigable only by very small canoe, possibly, at the highest tides, by means of intersecting rivulets and drains, which might effect a junction, Hay dismisses the observations stating that they were unfounded, based only on hearsay, and that he questions Boteler's conviction to obtain results.
