- All stamp designs must be completed on the stamp template. You may reproduce as many copies of the stamp template as needed.
- Draw a design of your choice using pencil, colored pencil, marker, or paint. Photos, computer generated art and/or collages are not acceptable media for this contest.
- All designs must include a denomination (either as: 44¢, 44 Cents, or Forty Four Cents) and the country of origin (either as: USA, United States, or United States of America).
- Each student must complete the entry form and attach it to the back of his/her work.
- Only one design per student may be entered into the contest.
- Submissions can only be entered by a teacher or school on behalf of the student.

Additional non-mandatory guidelines as set forth by the USPS Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee, found online at <http://www.usps.com/communications/organization/csac.htm>:

- No living person shall be honored by portrayal on U.S. postage.
- Only events, persons, and themes of widespread national appeal and significance will be considered for commemoration.
