

Dear Stamp Dealer.

The Rochester Philatelic Association will host ROPEX 2012 on May 18, 19, 20 at the Sports Centre at MCC at 2700 Brighton Henrietta Town Line Road. We cordially invite you to participate in this national "World Series of Philately" exhibition. All booths will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. If this is your first invitation to a ROPEX show, we hope you decide to participate in our event. If you have participated in past years, join us again.

ROPEX is being held in the southern suburb of Henrietta, only a 10 minute drive from the city center, the airport, or the New York State Thruway. The show is being held in Ice Rink #1 (sorry, we'll melt the ice beforehand!) and is air conditioned or heated as necessary. The area is Rochester's most prolific for hotels, restaurants and shopping.

ROPEX features up to 32 dealers and 240 frames of competitive exhibits. We draw most collectors from a 100 mile radius around Rochester, which includes Buffalo, Syracuse, Albany, New York's southern tier, Pennsylvania, Ohio, and Canada. We advertise in both philatelic newspapers and non-philatelic regional publications covering a broad area of western/central New York. Our yearly show mailing is sent to over 1,700 collectors in the region.

ROPEX has an "Early Bird" bourse on Friday before the show opens to the public between 9:30-11 AM. Early entrance for non-ROPEX dealers, cachet makers' bourse participants and collectors is \$20. The building will be open for ROPEX dealers at 8:00 AM daily.

Plans are already underway for what can only be described as western New York's largest stamp show ever in 2013 when the American Topical Association comes to Rochester, hosting their annual National Topical Stamp Show (NTSS) with us. "ROPEX and NTSS 2013: Two Shows in One" will be the first time two separate World Series of Philately shows take place at the same time in the same location. Each show will have their own exhibits and judges but share a common "super bourse" of dealers. The ATA is America's second largest philatelic organization with 5,000 members. They are already planning a full complement of meetings for their members attending the 2013 show. This is also the Rochester Philatelic Association's 100th anniversary show!

Enclosed you will find a copy of the contract for your future booth space. Please respond to this invitation as soon as possible with a \$100 table fee deposit and a signed contract. The balance will be due at the time of sign-in for the show. ROPEX dealers from the year before have until **September 1** to reserve their former table locations.

Take Down: ROPEX will close at 3:00 PM on Sunday. Please conclude any business with your customers

in advance of this time.

Only dealers, exhibitors, RPA/ROPEX Committee members or authorized assistants will be allowed in the hall after 3:00 PM. Note that ROPEX show times are well advertised to the public. Dealers may not leave prior to the official closing time. Make your departure plans accordingly. Lack of adherence to these rules will jeopardize your participation in future

ROPEX shows.

Loading assistance <u>may</u> be available for an hour after 3:00 PM. Be aware that the exhibits

and frames are also taken down and dismantled at this time.

ROPEX and the DEALER agree to the following:

1) The ROPEX Bourse Committee agrees to furnish the dealer with booth space at ROPEX to be held at the date, location, and times specified per the following schedule:

ROPEX 2012 – May 18-20 at The Sports Centre at MCC ROPEX-NTSS 2013: Two Shows in One – May 17-19 at The Sports Centre at MCC

Additional front tables may be ordered at \$175 per table. One free back table will be given for every 2 fronts ordered. Additional back tables are available at \$50 each. Extra patron chairs are available for \$10 each.

(ROPEX reserves the right to change the floor plan/table locations when necessary before show time)

Cachet Makers' Bourse- \$35 1 - 8' front table, 4 chairs (Table locations at the discretion of ROPEX) 1 day only, Saturday, from Noon-5 PM (minimum of 3 dealers must sign up by April 1 for this to take place)

- 1) Dealers must provide their own tablecloths for all front/side tables. Dealers are obliged to staff their booth throughout all show hours until 3 PM Sunday unless prior arrangements have been made with the bourse chairman in advance. Departure before this time is considered a breach of contract.
- 2) The ROPEX Committee will take all necessary and practical steps to insure the safety and careful treatment of materials during the exhibition. However, no responsibility shall be attached to the Rochester Philatelic Association, Inc., ROPEX, the Town, the ESL Sports Centre or its staff, the Executive Committee nor its employees or voluntary assistants, for anything whatsoever. The ROPEX Committee will provide security personnel for the duration of the exhibition. Dealers will be responsible for their own insurance coverage.
- 3) There will be no selling or sharing of booth space without ROPEX Bourse Chairman's permission. The Bourse Chairman will have absolute discretion in the location of booths. Every effort will be made to comply with requested booth position locations. ROPEX is predominantly a philatelic exhibition, however related ephemera, post cards, and numismatic items are allowed as well.
- 4) Payments are to be made in U.S. funds. A \$100 deposit must accompany the application per show.
- 5) If ROPEX does not take place, the ROPEX Committee will be responsible only for the return of the deposit submitted with the application.
