## Meter Stamp Society General Exhibit Award

The Meter Stamp Society offers a General Exhibit Award for philatelic exhibits that prominently explore one or more of the alternate postage products that the Society follows. The award will consist of

- a. A certificate prepared by the MSS and
- b. A two year membership to the MSS.

## Criterion

- 1. The winner of this award will be chosen from philatelic exhibits that may be single or multiple frame and may be of any class including thematic. It may also be a literature exhibit.
- 2. The exhibit may include traditional postage meter stamps, personal postage stamps, custom postage stamps or computer vended postage. These types of postage stamps are described at the MSS website <a href="https://www.meterstampsociety.com">www.meterstampsociety.com</a> or in literature listed in the Bibliography at that site. The candidate exhibits may include a thematic exhibit that does an exemplary job of using these types of materials in its story development.
- 3. It is anticipated that new types of postage may be adopted after this document is written. New postage types of interest to the MSS will be duly published in the Meter Stamp Society Journal (formerly the Bulletin).
- 4. The exhibitor does not need to be a member of the MSS, however, nonmembers must accept the membership as part of the award.
- 5. There need not be more than one exhibit from which to choose. The judges may choose to give the award to a well prepared exhibit. If exhibits of this type are present but not considered exemplary the judges may choose not to present the award.
- 6. The judges are asked to present the award to the exhibit that best represents the interests of the MSS as stated above.
- 7. The judges must send title and exhibit class of the exhibit, and the name and address of the awardee to the MSS Awards Chairman. The MSS would greatly appreciate a copy of the synopsis and title page of the exhibit if at all possible.
- 8. If the judges choose not to award a suitable exhibit, the MSS would appreciate being informed that the exhibit was present so that the MSS can send a letter to the exhibitor to show our appreciation and to offer assistance.
