"WHAT DO I DO NOW?"

This is a question that at one time or another most collectors ask themselves when they have obtained all of the items they can find or afford in a traditional "one of each" collecting approach.

While Hawaii issued only 88 stamps before being annexed by the United States, this exhibit demonstrates to collectors and/or potential collectors how they may develop a never ending approach to their collecting interest.

A willingness to diversify and to do some research can be rewarded with increased knowledge, and a growing interest in a hobby that has no limits in the way you choose themes to pursue.
