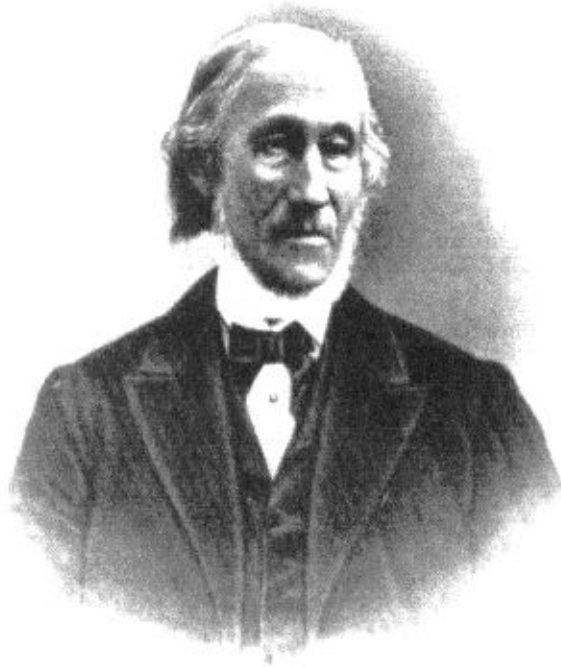


POSTMARKED



Abelard Reynolds

The first postmaster of Rochester, New York was appointed in 1812, Abelard Reynolds. In 1813, the first Post Office was opened in his house. Around four pieces of mail were dispatched on average on each weekly run. After the completion of the first Reynolds Arcade in 1829, the Post office was moved there.

This exhibit shows first early Rochester postmarks and usages, and then later usages. The exhibit also shows Rochester related material with revenues and Cinderella material.
