Lilac Festival-May 9-18, 2014

For two weeks in May, gardens everywhere are a mass of billowy purple, pink, white and wine-colored blooms, filling the air with scent on warm sunny days. Rochester's famous Lilac Festival, an annual event for over 100 years, is a celebration of the lavish array of flowers, attractions, and special events that signal the arrival of spring. The 1,200-plus lilac bushes in Highland Park create a floral rainbow

ranging from the deepest of purples to the purest of whites. The park's lilac collection was started by horticulturist John Dunbar in 1892 with 20 varieties, some of which were descendants of slips of native Balkan Mountain flowers that were carried to the new world by early colonists.
