The above Penny Red Perfin example is **B3480.01** this number is assigned as the register number in the **Great Britain Perfin Index.** The technical specification for the perfins follows: Date of usage, Manufacturer of the Perfin die, number of pins, the company that used this Perfin, the type of business and the Post office cancellations found on this Perfin.
