ROPEX/NTSS 2013 Update







There is so much going on as we work towards putting on a great stamp show this coming May 17-19 that it's hard to decide what to mention first. This joint venture with the American Topical Association has had its challenges but the results will far outweigh them.

As of now ROPEX has sold out 24 of our 30 available dealer tables. The ATA is in charge of selling their allocation of 21 tables, making a possible total of 51 dealers attending next year.

Exhibit applications have already trickled in, the earliest we have ever received entries.

The ATA is scheduling some 20 different meetings covering a variety of subjects in thematic collecting.

Youth activities will be in full-force at the show.

The ROPEX Board has extended an invitation to Stamp Camp USA to host up to three camps during the show. Each all-day series of miniclasses for kids aged 8-14 introduces them to our hobby through fun activities, culminating in an auction where everyone can bid on items for their own collections.

Our 2012 ROPEX youth Design-A-Stamp competition was a success that we want to build on in 2013. To that end, the competition is open to <u>any</u> student in three grade categories, 3-6, 7-9 and 10-12. Entries can be produced in any media and with any subject. The cash prizes are \$75 for first place, \$50 for second place and \$25 for third place for each category and grade group. Further rules and an official entry form can be found on our web site, write for one or ask for one at an RPA meeting.

Attention members! Do you know of kids who might be interested in designing a stamp

or attending Stamp Camp? We are depending on <u>you</u> to spread the word about these two opportunities to relatives, friends, neighbors and acquaintances.
