


This single-frame, display class exhibit will illustrate the connection between writing letters and getting mail. Snoopy, the good-natured beagle from the comic strip Peanuts, will introduce the viewer, especially children, to the world of letter writing, and then stamp collecting. The concept of stamp and cover collecting is much easier to understand if one first understands the use of postage stamps; to enable the sending and receiving of mail. Once a child is getting mail of their own, addressed directly to them, the jump to stamp collecting becomes much easier.




This notebook cover shows Charlie Brown and Snoopy at the mail box with lots of mail.
